Preserving the original millwork and doors wherever possible retained the building's character. Selective demolition was performed to uncover and highlight the hidden treasure of original brickwork and to expose original structural beams.

The main floor level is home to the main showroom and staff area. The upper level serves as the workroom. A full building camera security system was incorporated and all HVAC, plumbing, and electrical systems were completely replaced.
